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**I.R.I.S.-Docutec Enters the Dutch Health Care Market with a
DMR-Technology from Germany**

*Thanks to XClassify, CZ-Actief in Gezondheid now handles all of its
incoming invoices and declarations*

Aachen/Louvain-la-Neuve, February 3rd 2009 - I.R.I.S.-Docutec is expanding its relationship with the Dutch health insurer “CZ Actief in Gezondheid”. Due to the excellent classification results and mainly the ease of use of Docutec-software “XClassify” I.R.I.S.-Docutec was chosen as the technology partner for the implementation of this new DMR solution. With the I.R.I.S.-Docutec DMR classification solution, CZ is now able to classify all of its customers’ claims. CZ is one of the three largest medical insurance companies in the Netherlands and has, since 2005, processed up to six million invoices every year with Docutec software X4D.

As one of the largest medical insurers in the Netherlands, the 2700 employees of CZ Actief in Gezondheid care for around 3,3 million insured people. Founded in 1915 the established company defines itself as a service provider in the area of “living healthy and staying healthy”. CZ has head offices in Tilburg, Goes and Sittard as well as over 20 service centers nationwide.

Due to some changes in the Digital Mailroom (centralization of scanning, integration of all incoming mail, optimization of current process) I.R.I.S.-Docutec was invited to a benchmark of its XClassify component for the Digital Mailroom (DMR). And this benchmark was very successful: *“The reasons for choosing I.R.I.S.-Docutec over competition are the excellent classification results, the transparency, fastness and easy use of XClassify, which allows us to do this project on our own”*, says Han Tanis, IT-director of CZ. *“Due to the fact that Docutec has 15 years of experience in the DMS market and also a perfect fit with international partners in different industries made the choice much more relevant”*, he adds. Furthermore CZ did not want to buy a “black box”. Due to the fact that the documents in the mailroom will change very quickly CZ wants to develop the solution on their own in order to react on changes very quickly.



Claims like invoices from a dentist or a pharmacy are now classified with the I.R.I.S.-Docutec software. For the Dutch insurer this means a strong optimization and simplified operational procedures by handling all incoming claims in one solution. In the future CZ plans to classify all incoming documents with X4D.

“We train them as a partner and they behave as a partner. We have the technology and they have the knowledge of the market. With CZ as our partner we learned a lot how to combine our DMR classification technology and the specific market knowledge of CZ in order to build an optimized solution for this dedicated market”, as Docutec’s Executive Leo Vondenbusch points out. He wants to encourage other firms in the sector to get in a partnership with Docutec, too: “If CZ can optimize the process of classifying incoming documents, other companies can do the same way”.
